As you review this list, be mindful of the various uses of the term "day." "Business day" means Monday through Friday, except for federal and state holidays (unless holidays are specifically included in the designation of business days). "School days" are any days, including a partial day, during the regular school year that students are in attendance at school for instructional purposes.
